It is with sadness and a deep sense of loss that we learnt of the untimely passing of a most valued commissioner/board member of the Securities and Exchange Commission of Zimbabwe, Mrs. Florence Ziumbe, on Monday 16 August 2021. She was an experienced lawyer and a seasoned professional who served in many capacities to secure a better Zimbabwe for future generations. She was appointed as a Commissioner on 01 November 2016 and served in the Licensing, Litigation & Legislative committee as its Chairman, as well as in the Investor Education and Human Resources committees. During her tenure, Florence was diligent and exercised her independent voice to promote high levels of corporate governance and performance from management.

FLORENCE ERINAH ZIUMBE was born on 27th February 1957 and graduated with a Bachelor of Law (Honours) Degree in 1980 and a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1981 from the University of Zimbabwe. Mrs. Ziumbe was registered as Legal Practitioner in 1982 and practiced law as senior partner at Ziumbe & Partners in Harare at the time of her death. She specialised in corporate and commercial work. Mrs. Ziumbe founded and was first President of PROWEB, a professional women's association. She was a member of the Law Society of Zimbabwe, the Zimbabwe Women's Lawyers Association, and was Deputy Chairman of the State Procurement Board for thirteen years.
